HOLY LAND OLIVE WOOD ARTIFACTS SALE

Representatives from Bethlehem Christian Families will be with us the **weekend of May 11-12** to ask for your help and blessing for the native people of the Holy Land in Bethlehem. Sixty years ago, these families made up 18% of the population. Due to recent events in the Middle East, it has caused these families to face devastating economical strain, and caused the population to decrease to less than 2% in the Holy Land. These families have relied on the income from their religious hand carved olive wood artifacts to tourists. This is an opportunity for us to help support these families as all proceeds will be sent back to the families of the Holy Land so they may be able to keep their homes and provide for their families. The last few years were very tough for the Christian families and this is the only source of income for them. Thank you for your support.
