Mission Field Updates

Greetings to "Our Mission Field!"

Last weekend at all our Mission Field Masses the priests shared with people two SUPER important things for us to be mindful of. We hope and pray you will be generous with your support in both matters. We have been very overwhelmed with the support, encouragement and assurances of your prayers! Thank you!

First off, we as a priest team, invite you to prayerfully consider how you can support our Bishop's Ministry Appeal for the Diocese of Duluth. This appeal supports our priests, supports our seminarians' education needs, supports our permanent deacon program, supports the great work Fr. Mike Schmitz is doing at the University of Minnesota Duluth, supports the publication of the Northern Cross, supports our ministry to those in prisons and hospitals, provides a tremendous number of resources and support to our parish staffs across the Diocese, and so much more. Over the past number of decades many of us have been familiar with the United Catholic Appeal and the seminarian appeal—in the simplest way of saying this: the new "Ministries Appeal" is the combination of those former appeals—into a new name and brand. Each of our parishes is asked to reach a particular goal and if we do not reach that goal, we will have to take from our operating expenses, which we truly hope we can prevent. Each of our Mission Field parishes have had varying levels of success with this appeal. Please be generous and let's ALL reach our goal!

We often tell people to strive for tithing 10% of what God blesses you with – some households can do more, and some do less – but that is a good number to shoot for. 5% should go to your parish, 2.5% to our Diocese and 2.5% to your favorite mission/charity. Again – everyone handles this a bit differently and NOBODY likes discussing these things, but we as a priest team must encourage, challenge and invite our people to be generous.

Secondly, last weekend all the priests announced that we would be moving into a new Mass/Confession/Adoration Schedule at the parishes in our Mission Field. Each parish is being asked to make some "slight" changes so we can better order our Mass Schedules. We as a priest team brought these proposals to our Deacon Team, our Trustees, our parish staffs and to all the nine parish meetings this last month. During those discussions we received overwhelming support to move ahead. Some of our basic principals were to stagger times so no parishes are having Mass at the same time and to have as much equality as possible across the Mission Field based on the current numbers of people attending Mass. Starting on September 30th this will be our new Mission Field Mass Schedule...
